

## **How will the curriculum be adapted to my child's needs?**

Teachers and staff try to plan engaging and motivating lessons that encourage children to enjoy learning and reach their full potential. Often, small changes within the classroom are enough for a child with SEND to make progress and teachers try to ensure they use a range of different strategies to support children's learning. This might include:

- A change in teaching approach – active learning, real life experiences, drama, talking partners, relearning of vocabulary, opportunities to develop problem solving;
- Adapting resources and equipment – writing slopes and pen grips, scribes, supportive writing scaffolds, using ICT for recording. iPad Apps used to support writing, coloured overlays and backgrounds;
- Using the environment – visual timetables, displays, seating and groupings, concrete apparatus.
