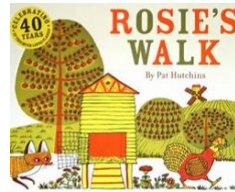

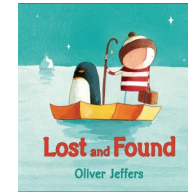
We will be

Mathematical Development

- Comparing groups of objects.
- Combining two groups to find the whole.
- Understanding about length, height and distance.
- Using the language 'more, less'.

Welcome back! We hope you had an enjoyable Christmas break. Happy New Year to you all. We are looking forward to another exciting term. This Term our theme is "Let's go on a Journey" where we will explore the habitats in the Polar Region and finding out about some of the animals that live there.

PSED

Knowledge and Understanding of the World.

- Through the story of Lost and Found, children will be finding out about reversible changes involving ice (melting) and how this can be sped up.

Phonics

- The children will be learning to blend to read e.g. d-o-g dog and segmenting a word to spell (sounding the word out on their fingers).
- Learning to read words we can't sound out e.g. the, to, no, go, into, you, he, she, we, me, was.
- Learning to read and write simple captions e.g. a *nap in a cot* or *run to the den*.

Physical Development

We will be

- Continuing to develop fine and gross motor skills.
- Forming letters correctly.
- Taking part in yoga on a Monday and P.E. on a Friday.
- Continuing to work independently, in pairs and in small groups.
- The children will learn how to throw and catch a variety of different sized and shaped objects including balls, quoits, and beanbags.

Creative development

We will be

- Penguin inspired art work.
- Drawing penguins.
- Using large boxes to help us imagine that we are rowing a boat in the roleplay area.
- Sculpt and make a clay penguin.
