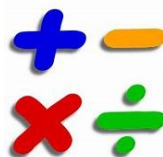

- Time

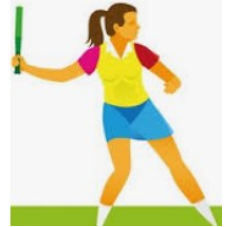


This term in **Maths**, Year 4 will be learning about:
