

UKS2 Summer 1 Curriculum Bulletin Driving Forces

In **English**, we will be revising grammatical skills that we can use to improve our writing. We will be applying these skills in short burst writing and a variety of different genres over the term.

This term in **History**, we will be learning about the ancient Kingdom of Benin. We will look at where it was located and what society was like during the time. We will learn what happened to the kingdom and how and why it ended. We will be interpreting and interrogating different evidence.



In **Religious Education**, the children will be looking at how religions use the arts to express their beliefs.



In **PSHE**, Year 5 will explore how to keep safe and manage risks. Year 6 will be continuing their relationship and sex education before looking at keeping safe and managing risks.



In **Spanish**, we will be learning about sports and leisure activities that they like and dislike and the times their activities start/ finish.



Important Information:

Year 5 homework is set on a Friday and is to be handed in by Wednesday. Year 6 homework is set Monday-Thursday with spellings set on a Friday.

It is essential that your child's reading book and record is in school **every day**. We ask that your child reads at least 5 times a week and logs on to Times Table Rock Stars on a regular basis to sustain fluency.


Please could you ensure your child's PE kit is in school every day.


This term in **Maths**, Year 5 will be learning about:

- Decimals
- Percentages
- Properties of shapes



This term in **Maths**, Year 6 will be learning about:

- Imperial and metric units of measure
- Perimeter, area and volume
- Properties of shapes
- Statistics



In **Physical Education**, we will be developing our athletic skills. Miss Kirkby and Miss Belcher's class will be learning about cricket. Miss Daubney's class will be swimming.
