**At Waddington Redwood Primary Academy, we aim to offer a wealth of different activities both during, and after school. Our extra-curricular activities are really important to us as it provides further opportunities to ‘grow into mighty redwoods’ for our children, for them to excel further as Redwood Learners and provide the opportunity to explore and develop new interests and talents. Our extensive programme offers children the chance to develop skills which go beyond the school curriculum.**

#### **What kinds of opportunities will be available to my child?**

We have carefully considered the range of provision on offer to cover art, sport, STEM, music and life skills. You may notice slightly more clubs on offer for older year groups; this reflects there being more classes in KS2. We have increased the number of clubs available for pupils in KS1 in 2025 and will continue to develop our offer.

#### **Who will be running these sessions?**

A significant number of sessions will be run by external providers who are experts in their fields. We are delighted to have built strong relationships with these providers and that our pupils get the chance to benefit from their knowledge, skill and experience. A number of sessions will be run by the school staff team who will be giving their time to offer children these opportunities after school.

#### **Why is there a charge for some clubs?**

Due to the high quality of external providers, some clubs require a charge to ensure they can be offered to pupils and have the capacity to run. It also covers the use of resources which may be needed to run the club. You will be given the option to pay in two instalments to help spread the cost.

**All clubs start straight after school and finish at 4:20pm.**

**\* Cook Stars is slightly longer, finishing at 4:45pm.**

#### **Why do children need to commit to a half term?**

Numerous research studies highlight the academic and social benefits of sustained extra-curricular engagement. Just like clubs the children may attend at weekends, the longer children commit to developing a new skill, the more successful they are likely to become.

We have therefore decided that children should therefore ‘commit’ at least 1 half term to develop a new skill before reviewing if they wish to continue.

Children that register for a club but are not successful this half term will be contacted before the beginning of the following term to see if they are still interested in a place before we open up the spaces to all pupils, giving everyone an equal opportunity to take part in a club each academic year.

#### **How do I book?**

The window for registering for clubs starting in Autumn 2 2025 will be **Tuesday 14th October - Sunday 19th October**. You can register your interest in a club by following the link and completing the form which can be found under each club description in this booklet. Places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. After this deadline, we will contact families to let them know whether their child has a place on the club and then payment details will become available (if necessary) for you to confirm your child’s place.

**Unless stated, all after school clubs will begin the week commencing Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025 and finish week commencing Monday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2025, running for 6 weeks.**

**Please note no clubs will be running in the last week of half term (w/c 15<sup>th</sup> December).**

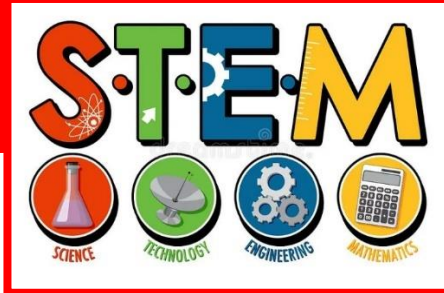
## Choir (KS1 & KS2)
